Professor K.K. Basa, Vice Chancellor Maharaja Sriram Chandra Bhanja Deo University, expressed his gratitude to the Hon'ble Chancellor. He took the opportunity to thank Professor Deepak Kumar Behera, Vice Chancellor, and all members of the Academic Council and pointed out the followings:

- i) Since the students belong to the tribal background, the teachers should create a congenial environment of teaching and follow interactive mode of teaching.
- ii) Most of the tribal children are first generation learners, and they should be taught in such a manner that they will be the catalysts of socio-cultural uplift of their respective communities.

The Vice Chancellor, KISS-DU appreciated the thoughtful suggestions and deliberations and suggested that we should sincerely try to follow these up.

Professor K.K. Misra, Former Vice Chancellor, Utkal University of Culture expressed his thanks to the Hon'ble Chancellor, KISS-DU for his gracious presence in the meeting of the Academic Council. He also submitted that, KISS is a wonderful platform for the tribal students to learn and achieve new heights. He also said that, it is right time to enhance the academic quality of KISS-DU, since KISS Foundation has already earned worldwide reputation. Professor Basanta Kumar Panda, Director, Centre for Excellence for studies in Classical Odia, Govt. of India, gave his opinion on the aspects of language planning and pedagogic material production. He added that:

(i) There should be research between the Odia language and tribal languages. He also pointed out the multi-lingual work should be undertaken on 62 tribes and on different tribal languages.

(ii) Teachers should not teach the students only, they should be ready to learn from their students too. KISS is the appropriate platform for achieving this.
