

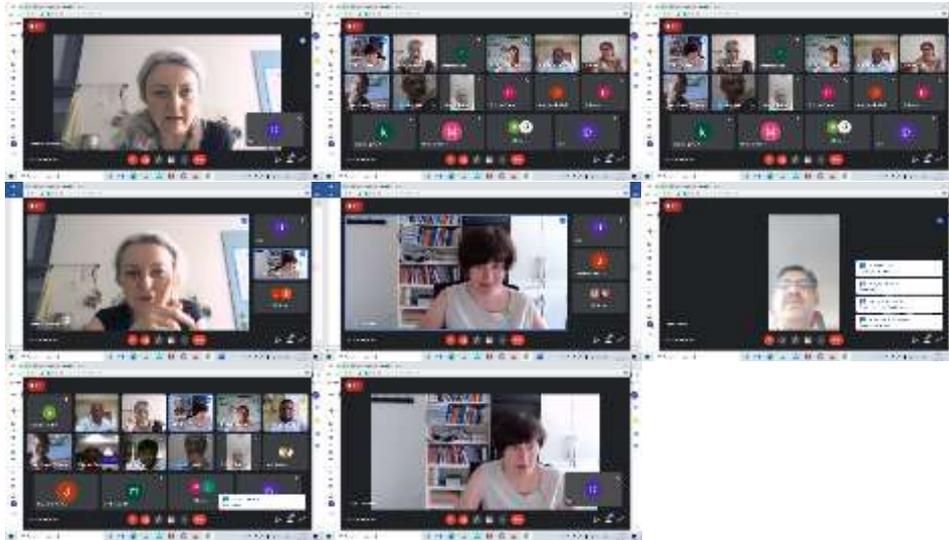
## Day-wise Details of the training cum workshop

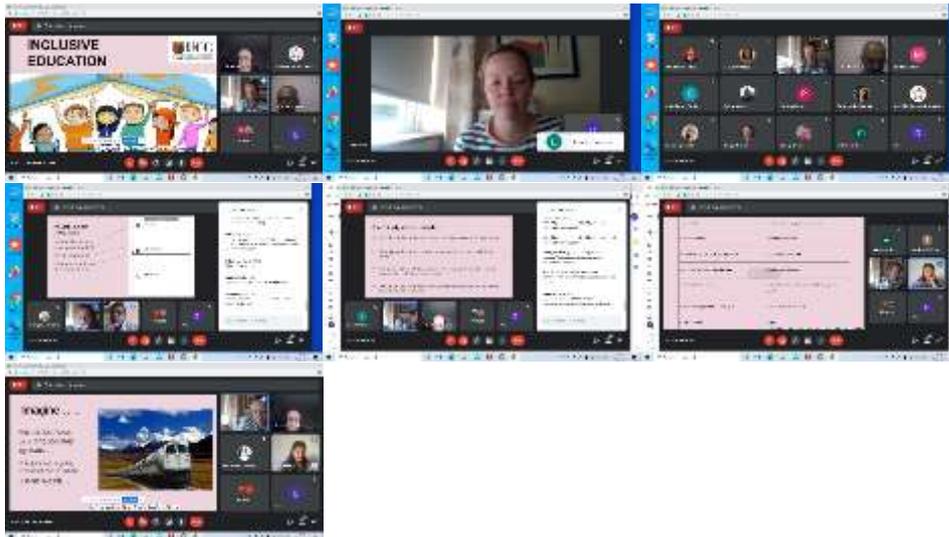
### Day – 2 (22/06/21)

The session included various inclusionary practices and how the same can be used in classrooms. It also talked about active learning methodologies and strategies and the process of collecting feedback in class.

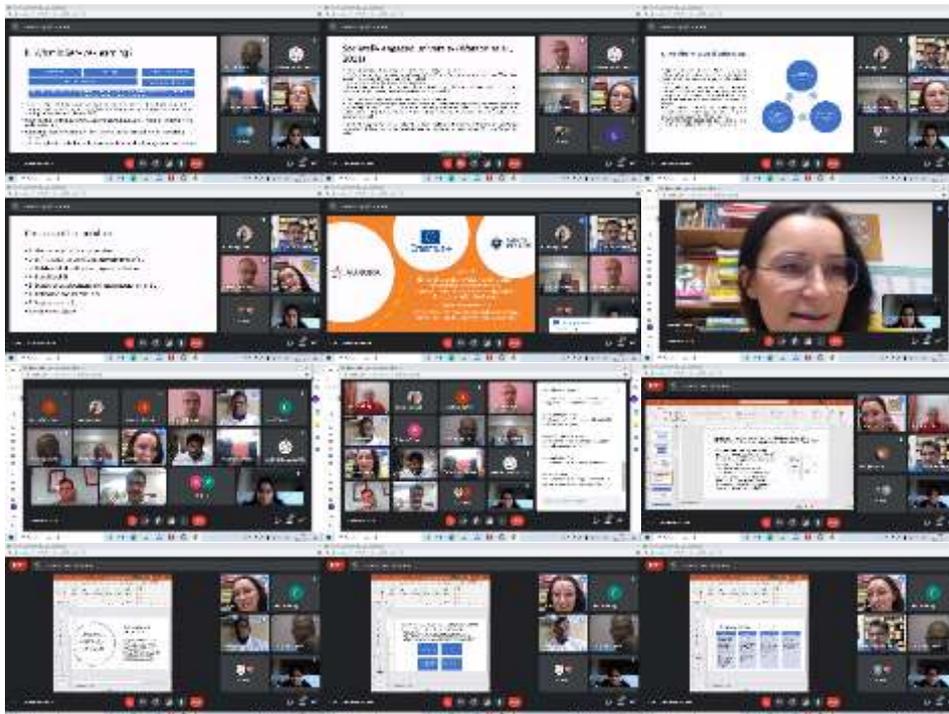




Day – 3 (23/06/21)

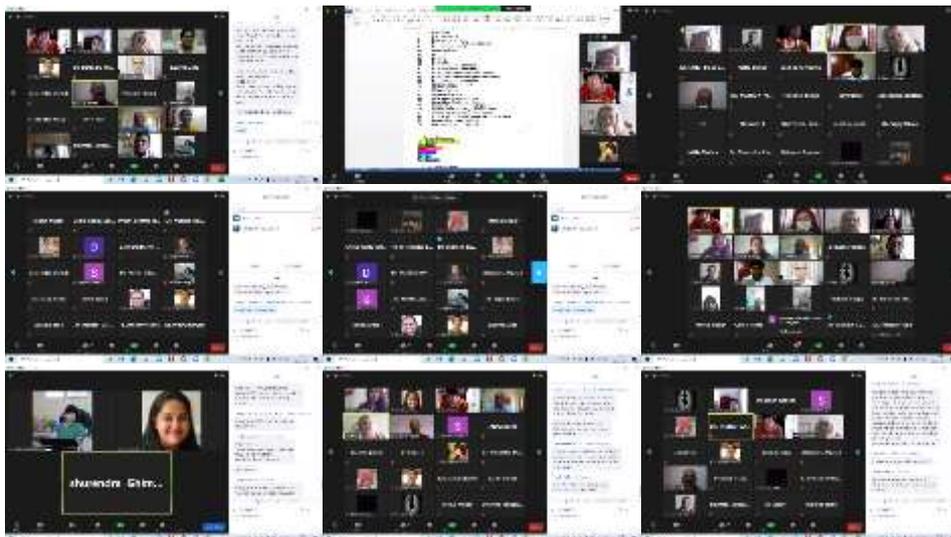


**Day – 4 (24/06/21)**

The session included reflections from the 1<sup>st</sup> session and the use of breakout rooms for open discussions focused on perspective building exercises and sharing.

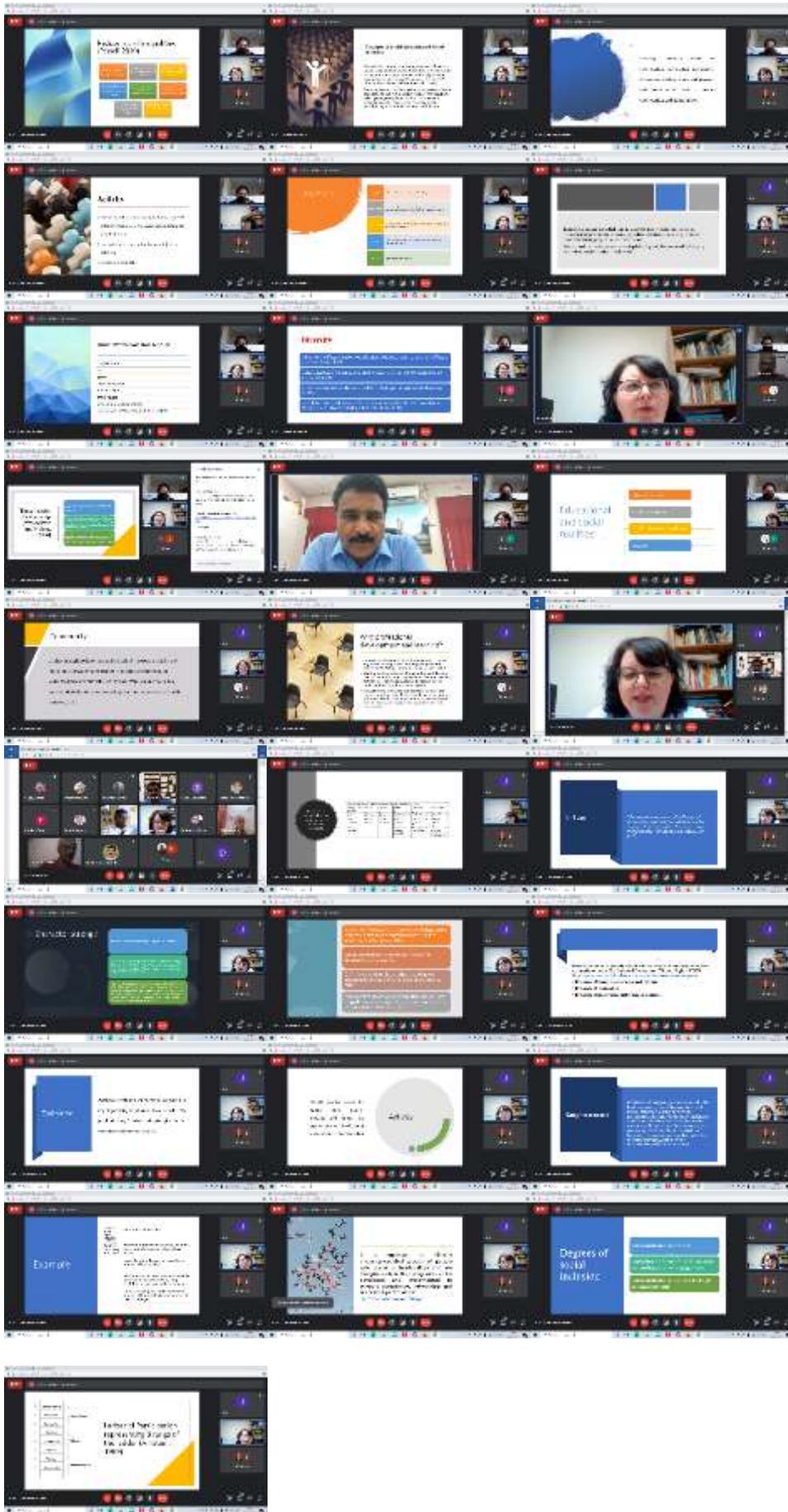


**Day – 5 (25/06/21)**

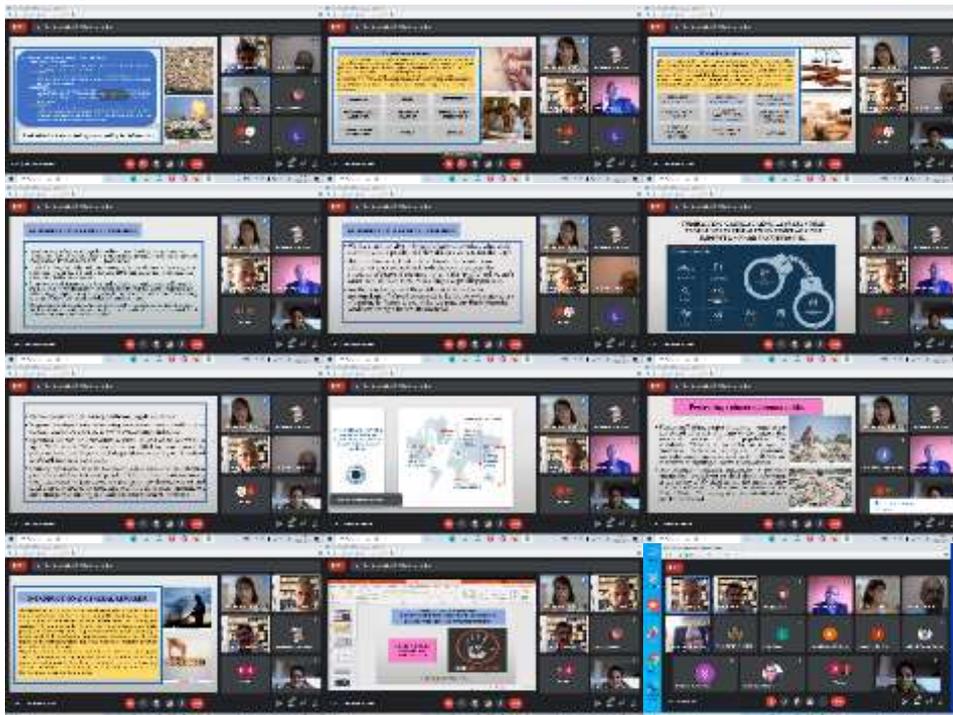

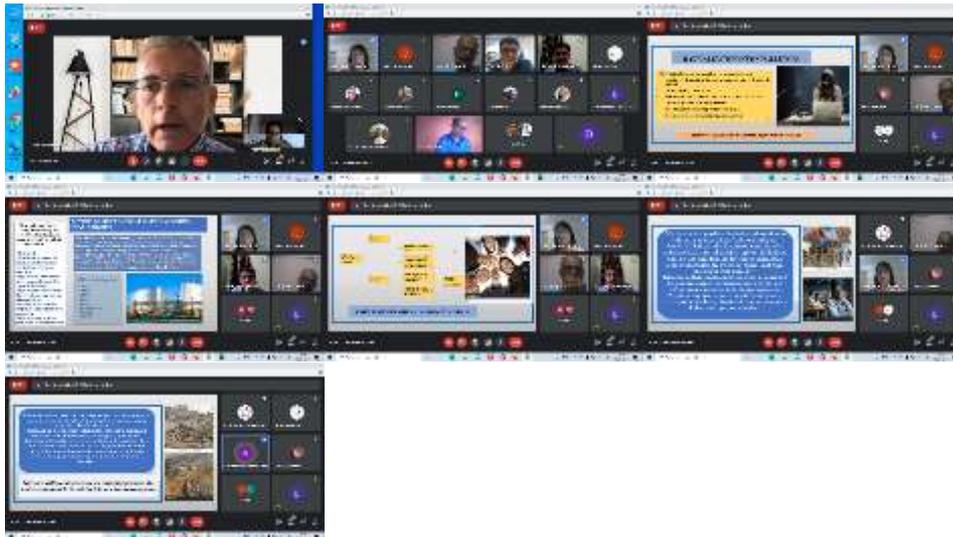
**Day 7 (29/06/21)**

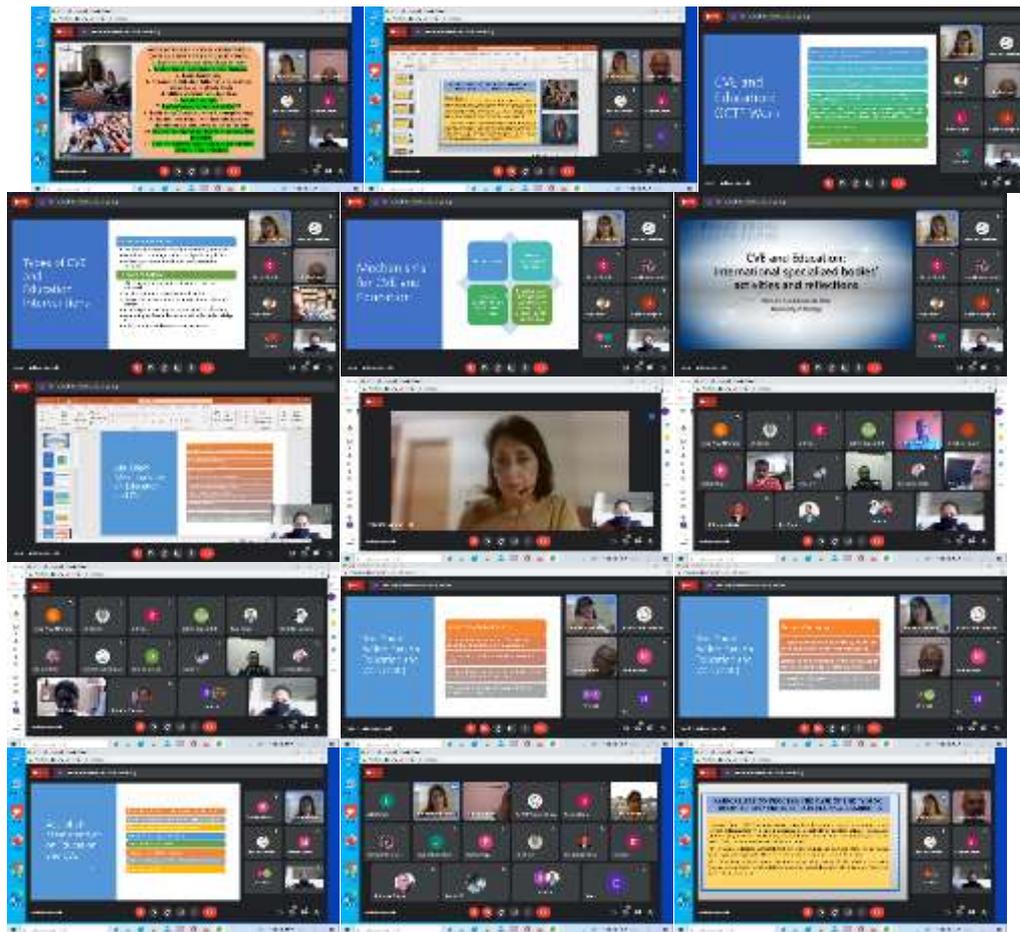
